National strategy to manage and live with wildland fire on the landscape

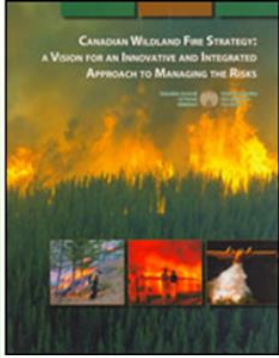

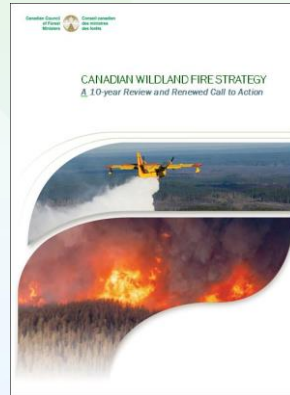
